

REVIEW PROCESS

Review Process and Decision Descriptions

Within four weeks of being submitted, each journal paper undergoes a preliminary review by the journal editor. The journal editor decides among four options for routing the paper:

- Send out for review
- Return without review (outside of scope)
- Return without review (grammar/syntax)

When a journal paper is reviewed, one of the following options are available.

- Accept in present form
- Revise for Editor Only
- Re-review required
- Declined final
